## Unifor Local 111 Bursaries

Sisters and Brothers,

Unifor Local 111 annually offers a total of 2 bursaries for \$2500.00 each. These bursaries are awarded to children of Unifor Members in good standing who are currently registered to enter into any Canadian accredited post-secondary education (university, community college, technological institute, teachers' college, nursing school, etc.) with a full time course load.

*(note: applications will not be retained – new applications are required annually)*

Submissions should include:

- An official application form (attached) that has been signed by a Local 111 Officer
- Transcript/record of marks (most current record, ie: mid-term report is acceptable)
- A letter of recommendation from a teacher, principal or other community figure

Please note that, unlike many bursaries awarded by other institutions, grades are only one of several factors that will be considered.

Upon receipt of all applications, the Unifor Local 111 Education Committee will immediately submit all applications to the Unifor National Education department. They will make the final selections based on the content of all material received. The decision of the Unifor National Education department is final.

Completed submissions should be received by **April 25<sup>th</sup>, 2018**
