When is the next “TEST EMAIL BALLOT”?

“Test Email Ballot 2” began **Wednesday, July 29th @ 8:00**. You have until **Friday, July 31st @ 23:59** to confirm your email.

The test has started and I have not received my test ballot.

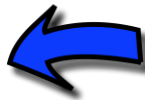
Please do the following if you have not received your “Test Email Ballot 2”

1. **Check** that your Inbox is not full.
2. **Check** your Spam/Junk folder (do a search for “Simply Voting”) and mark it as “Not Spam”
3. **Add** vote@simplyvoting.com to your address book or list of safe senders.
4. **Resubscribe** to Simply Voting by sending a blank email (using the email account you registered with the union) to resubscribe@simplyvoting.com

I followed those steps but still no email?

Simply Voting has been configured to automatically send email blast on **Wed, Thurs, Fri at 08:00, 12:00, 16:00** to those who have not yet voted in Test Email Ballot 2.

This is to include those who have updated their email throughout the day, resubscribed, as well as a reminder for those who have not completed their test ballot. In addition, manual email blasts can be sent on as needed.

How do I know that someone else did not update my email address to theirs, therefore, stealing my ballot?

When you filled in the jotform or phoned the support staff, your address was verified.

When is the deadline for me to update my information?

Friday, July 31st @ 15:00

I missed the deadline to update my email address; can I still vote?

No – to maintain security and integrity of the process, late registration will not be allowed, and paper ballots will not be available.

Will support staff be available during ratification vote to help?

No – this was the purpose of these test email ballots, not just to confirm/update members email, but to allow time for members to ask questions and get comfortable with the system.
